

# Dalbeattie - Heart stane

At the back of the heart, near the bottom, you will find the expected clue. It looks like this.



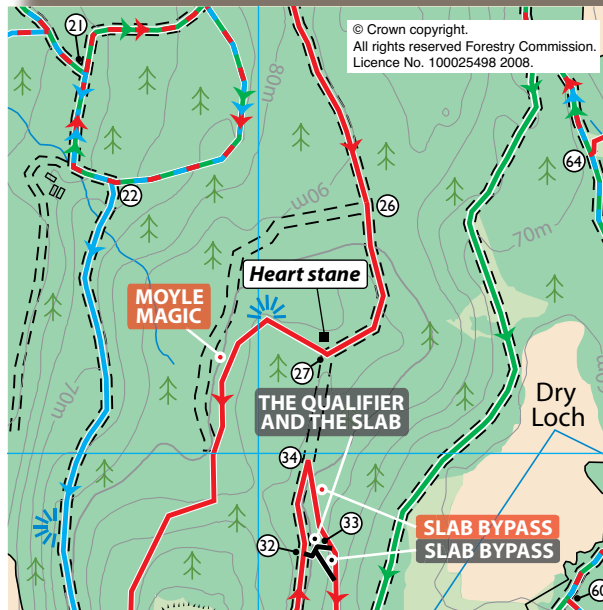
Once again the boxes represent letters. Take a note of them at the appropriate place on the back of this leaflet.

## On the hill the professor saw the stane and said:-

"It is in the form of a large granite, probably Dalbeattie granite, heart. It is surrounded by granite boulders and is overlooked by the site of an iron age hill fort. The object sits on a natural plinth constructed from soil and is thus in clear view from a great distance. It measures approximately 5ft 9 inches x 7ft 6 inches x 3ft 2 inches and probably weighs about 5 to 7 tons"

## How to get there...

**By Foot:** From the Richorn car park, enter the forest to the rear of the car park, using the forest road. Follow this for about 200m until you see the blue 7stanes waymarker posts. Follow the green arrows along the forest road for about 1km until red arrows appear. Now follow the arrows up the hill for another 1km, eventually leaving the green arrows and turning right to follow the red arrows for a further 1km. The stone is located where the red bike trail turns right off the forest road, and is clearly visible on a knoll to the right.

**By Bike:** From the 7stanes trailhead, follow the red grade 'Hardrock trail'. The stone is located about 3km along the trail.
